



Secondary Assistance Scheme

Parents of students in Year 7 to 12 may be eligible for up to \$350 towards school expenses

The allowance consists of two components:

\$235 Educational Program Allowance is paid directly to the school and is taken as payment for the Voluntary Contributions.

\$115 Clothing Allowance is paid directly to the parent/guardian to assist with purchasing of the school uniform or parents can opt to direct payment to the school to decrease outstanding balance of Voluntary Contributions and or Charges. Application is made by parents or guardians of students enrolled in Years 7 to 12 up to and including the year the student turns 18 years of age.

Parents/guardians must hold one of the following cards:

- Department of Human Services (Centrelink) Health Care Card
- Department of Human Services (Centrelink) Pensioner Concession Card
- Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card



The above cards must be current during first term. You can download an [Application Form](#) and bring in completed form **with** the current signed concession card. You may send the signed form and card in with your child. A school officer must be able to verify the details and signature on the form before it can be processed. Alternatively you may have a [Witnessing Officer](#) certifying the details and your signature.
