



## **Years 11-12 Compulsory Charges**

Payment for all courses in Years 11 and 12 are compulsory. There is no established maximum as charges depend on the subjects selected by the students. Payment for certificate courses is compulsory, and needs to be paid in full, by Week 3 of Term 1. If these are not paid then we would initiate the process of withdrawing your child from any certificate course and placing them into a lower cost subject. We rely on fee payments to cover the costs of teachers, staff, instructional materials and essential services that support the academic and extracurricular activities your child enjoys here at Morley Senior High School.
